

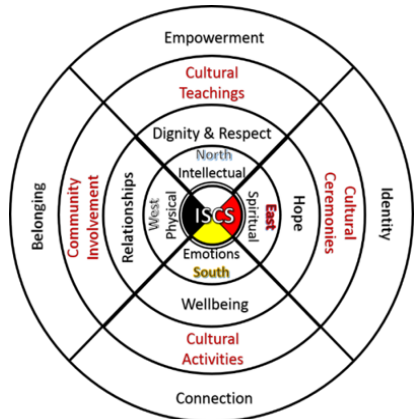
Indigenous Spiritual Care Services

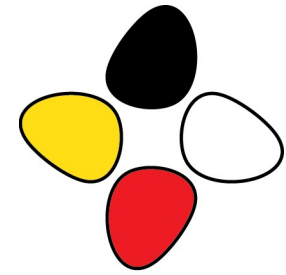

Residential Program

The Residential Program is just one of the programs offered at Life's Journey, which has been in operation since 2005. Agency-staffed residential care or cluster housing placements are available 24-hours a day, 7 days a week. Housing placement is based on individual needs and all Participants are supported toward their goals.

All Participants are able to access our cultural services, wellness programming, drop-in resources, and our community events and celebrations.
